Drylining fixing duties are:

- Install and repair metal stud partitions according to/in accordance with design details, specifications, manufacturers' recommendations and best practice guidelines
- Install and repair framed wall linings eg. metal dryliner channels, metal wall furrings, timber battens
- Install plywood pattresses according to specification and manufacturers' instructions
- Form framed and frameless beam and column in accordance with specification and manufacturers' instructions
- Form builders work holes and openings for windows and doors
- Form junctions, abutments and angles according to specification and manufacturers' instructions
- Recycle waste to contribute to zero/low carbon outcomes in the built environment

Taping and jointing / finishing duties are:

- Finishing dry lining walls and ceilings in a variety of settings
